SINGAPORE IP UPDATE 2017

IPOS to introduce fee changes with effect from 1 April 2017

The Intellectual Property Office of Singapore (IPOS) has announced that it will be introducing a series of fee changes, from 1 April 2017. All fee revisions will be effective for applications/requests <u>made</u> <u>on or after 1 April 2017</u>.

These changes are ultimately intended to help drive innovation and creativity in Singapore, through supporting Singapore businesses and entrepreneurs by making IP protection more accessible and affordable. IP owners will also be encouraged to actively use their IP, or to consider releasing non-performing IPs to the public domain, rather than hoarding IP, which can stifle innovation.

For patents, there will be reductions to the search fees as well as search and examination fees. The search and examination fees, which are currently \$\$2,600, will be reduced to \$\$1,950. For PCT international applications which have entered the Singapore national phase, there will be a further discount of \$\$300 for requesting search and examination if the international search report or international preliminary examination report had been established by IPOS. Fees for requesting a search report or supplementary search report, which are currently \$\$1,925, will be reduced to \$\$1,650.

For trade marks, application fees are reduced by 30% per class provided the specifications of goods and services filed utilize IPOS' pre-approved descriptions of goods and services. There are also fee reductions for Madrid international applications and transformation, which are currently S\$374 per class, to S\$341 per class, to align with national electronic filing fees.

Fees for requests to appoint, change or remove an agent for a matter relating to an IP, and requests to alter or correct name, address and other particulars, will be removed.

The other fee changes that IPOS will be implementing are listed as follows:

- New excess claim fee structure for patent applications (*i.e.* \$40 per claim in excess of 20 claims);
- Removal of fees for surrendering or cancelling IP;
- Increase in renewal fees for patents and trade marks. The fifty percent (50%) discount in renewal fees for patents under which licences are to be available as of right will however be continued.
